**SUNDAY 8 SEPT.** : **TIME: 10h00**  
**VENUE** : **DORMEHL FARM / CYCLE PATH / FARLEY FOREST STATION**

After ~4.3km from the N2, where the Karatara Road turns left, continue straight ~15km up the Barrington Road until you reach the Seven Passes Road. Turn right at the T-junction, where we will then meet.

**SUNDAY 3 NOVEMBER** : **TIME: 10h00**  
**VENUE** : **DIEPWALLE FOREST STATION**  
**DIRECTIONS** : Travelling eastwards on the N2, about 6 km east of Knysna, take the Uniondale turn-off to the left (R339) & drive for ±18km to the King Edward Big Tree which is on the left-hand side of the road. The entrance to the forestry station is almost directly opposite the entrance to the big tree. Remember your Wild Cards or pay the entrance fee.  
**TOPIC** : “Visit the indigenous tree arboretum” and introduction talk on the planting of indigenous trees at Diepwalle Forest Station and the forest museum. Followed by a short walk along the Elephant Walk.
